Job Title: Road Maintenance Worker

SUMMARY

Appointed by the Mayor to serve as the Road Maintenance Worker and to perform physical labor aimed at maintaining and repairing city roads; cleaning and digging ditches; removing snow and ice from roadways; and maintaining of city facilities, buildings, cemeteries and parks.

QUALIFICATIONS

Applicant must possess a high school diploma from an accredited high school or GED; must be at least 18 years of age; must possess and maintain a valid Ohio Commercial Driver License (minimum CDL B) and meet good driving record requirements; have prior experience in construction and maintenance work; and have a working knowledge of the operation, maintenance and repair of trucks, tractors and heavy equipment. Must be able to work in adverse weather conditions. Must be available for on-call emergency situations.

ESSENTIAL DUTIES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

- 1. Comply with the City's policy manual and departmental Standard Operating Procedures.
- 2. Communicate politely and effectively with the public, elected officials, coworkers and outside contractors.
- 3. Understand and follow oral and written instructions, read prints, maps and documents.
- 4. Assemble and erect road signs; dig holes and drive posts.

- 5. Carry and install culvert pipes.
- 6. Climb into and out of roadside ditches and culverts; remove dirt, leaves and debris from ditches and pipes.
- 7. Install, repair and maintain catch basins and storm water pipes; assist in cleaning and unclogging storm water lines.
- 8. Clear tree limbs and brush from roads; trim trees; operate chainsaw and brush chipper; cut and drag brush and large logs.
- 9. Operate tractor to cut grass and roadside weeds.
- 10. Operate leaf blowers to remove leaves and debris.
- 11. Operate heavy duty truck with snow plow attachments to remove snow and ice from roadways; operate salt spreader.
- 12. Shovel snow by hand; spread salt on walkways.
- 13. Shovel and rake asphalt to patch roadways.
- 14. Shovel and rake gravel to repair berms.
- 15. Perform maintenance at cemeteries and parks, as needed.
- 16. Pick up, carry and remove dead animals (i.e. deer) from roadway by hand.
- 17. Keep roadways clear of debris and in a safe condition at all times.
- 18. Perform maintenance of city facilities and buildings, as needed.
- 19. Operate excavation equipment (backhoe, front end loader, Gradall, etc.).
- 20. Set up work zones; flag traffic.
- 21. Clean buildings, floors and restrooms, as needed.
- 22. Adhere to applicable safety rules and regulations, report potential issues, and promote a safe working environment.
- 23. Perform necessary maintenance and limited repairs on all equipment and vehicles; clean and inspect equipment and vehicles after each use.
