Clinton Village Council voted unanimously last night to go with the Summit County Sheriff for police protection beginning January 1, 2017. All 911 calls made from Clinton will go to the Sheriff's Office. If the call is a fire or EMS call, the Sheriff will forward those to New Franklin for response since we have a Clinton/New Franklin fire agreement. Our proposal to Clinton was \$126,887.07 for 24/7 coverage annually for four years. The Sheriff's proposal was accepted last night at a rate of \$117,000 per year for 4 hours of service per day, this being a three year proposal.
