

**RESOLUTION NO: 16-R-01**  
**SPONSOR: MAYOR BOLLAS**  
**INTRODUCED: JANUARY 6, 2016**

**A RESOLUTION REQUESTING THAT THE SUMMIT COUNTY FISCAL OFFICER MAKE AN ADVANCED PAYMENT OF TAX FUNDS FOR TAX YEAR 2015 PAYABLE IN 2016 TO THE CITY OF NEW FRANKLIN AND DECLARING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON PASSAGE.**

WHEREAS, the City of New Franklin desires to request an advancement of local taxes from the Summit County Fiscal Officer pursuant to Ohio Revised Code Section 321.34; and

WHEREAS, the Summit County Fiscal Officer is requested to pay to the City of New Franklin funds as may be available for distribution of local taxes for the tax year 2015, payable in 2016.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

The Summit County Fiscal Officer is hereby requested to make advancements to the City of New Franklin of tax funds for tax year 2015, payable in 2016.

**SECTION TWO:**

The New Franklin Finance Director is hereby authorized to sign any and all necessary documents to secure such advances and to sign any and all necessary secondary documents to secure the semi-annual settlement with the Summit County Fiscal Officer during the calendar year 2016.

**SECTION THREE:**

The authorization contained herein shall extend to any advances that may be requested during the calendar year 2016. The Clerk of Council is hereby authorized and directed to certify and send a copy of this Resolution to the Summit County Fiscal Officer as may be necessary to make this Resolution effective.


**SECTION FOUR:**


The City of New Franklin finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberation of this Council and any other Committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.

**SECTION FIVE:**


Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of New Franklin. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.


