

**RESOLUTION NO: 16-R-06**  
**SPONSOR: MAYOR BOLLAS**  
**INTRODUCED: JANUARY 20, 2016**

**A RESOLUTION DECLARING THE NEED FOR THE NEW FRANKLIN SELF CONTAINED BREATHING APPARATUS PURCHASE PROJECT AND AUTHORIZING NEW FRANKLIN TO ADVERTISE FOR SEALED BIDS AND DECLARING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON PASSAGE.**

WHEREAS, New Franklin has been notified that it has been awarded an FY2014 Assistance to Firefighters Grant Award for \$147,825 for the purchase of Self Contained Breathing Apparatus and related accessories; and

WHEREAS, the cost estimate for this purchase exceeds \$50,000; and

WHEREAS, New Franklin Council deems it to be in the best interest of New Franklin to proceed with taking bids for the purchase of the Self Contained Breathing Apparatus and related accessories.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:**

**SECTION ONE:**

New Franklin City Council hereby declares the need for the Self Contained Breathing Apparatus Purchase Project.

**SECTION TWO:**

New Franklin City Council hereby authorizes the Mayor/New Franklin Fire Department to advertise a notice to bidders once per week for two weeks requesting bids for the Self Contained Breathing Apparatus Purchase Project.


**SECTION THREE:**



**SECTION FOUR:**




