INTRODUCED: JANUARY 20, 2016

A RESOLUTION RATIFYING A THREE-YEAR LABOR AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY OF NEW FRANKLIN AND LOCAL 2885 OF THE INTERNATIONAL ASSOCIATION OF FIREFIGHTERS AFL-CIO, CLC (IAFF) UNION AND DECLARING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON PASSAGE.

WHEREAS, the negotiating teams for the City of New Franklin and Local 2885 of the IAFF Union have reached a tentative three-year labor agreement; and

WHEREAS, New Franklin City Council desires to ratify the three-year tentative labor agreement.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

New Franklin City Council ratifies the three-year labor agreement between the City of New Franklin and Local 2885 of the IAFF Union, a copy which is attached hereto as Exhibit "A".

SECTION TWO:

New Franklin City Council authorizes and directs the Finance Director to make all payment necessary to effectuate the terms of the labor agreement.

SECTION THREE:

The terms and conditions of this collective bargaining agreement sets forth the wages, hours and working conditions of the employees represented by Local 2885 of the IAFF Union and supersedes all legislation of the City addressing any wages and benefits for such employees.

SECTION FOUR:


The City of New Franklin finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberations of this Council and other Committee that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.


SECTION FIVE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of New Franklin. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected


or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.
