INTRODUCED: FEBRUARY 17, 2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING THE RETURN OF FUNDS ADVANCED BY THE GENERAL FUND TO THE JAG GRANT FUND AND DECLARING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON PASSAGE.

WHEREAS, the City of New Franklin Council deems it necessary to return funds advanced by the General Fund to the JAG Grant Fund and;

NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The City of New Franklin Council hereby authorizes the return of the following advanced funds:

From the JAG Grant Fund (2603-110-5920 Advances Out) to the General Fund (1000-000-4941 Advances In) in the amount of \$6,648.25, effective January 31, 2016.


SECTION TWO:

The City of New Franklin finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this legislation were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberation of this Council and any other Committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.


SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of New Franklin. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.




