INTRODUCED: APRIL 6, 2016

A RESOLUTION AUTHORIZING NEW FRANKLIN TO APPLY FOR A LOCAL GOVERNMENT SAFETY CAPITAL GRANT FOR THE PURCHASE OF DIVER EQUIPMENT AND DECLARING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON PASSAGE.

WHEREAS, the New Franklin Fire Department has received notice that a Local Government Safety Grant for Operations and Safety Equipment is available; and

WHEREAS, New Franklin seeks to apply for grant funding for the purchase of sub surface diver equipment; and

WHEREAS, the grant will request the total of \$57,438.00 for the divers equipment with a 5% match by New Franklin of \$2,872.00; and

WHEREAS, Gatchell Grant Resources will write the Local Government Safety Capital Grant application at no charge; and

WHEREAS, if the grant is awarded, Gatchell Grant Resources will be entitled to a fee of \$1,500.00; and

WHEREAS, New Franklin Council deems it to be in the best interest of New Franklin to apply for this grant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

New Franklin is authorized to apply for a Local Government Safety Capital Grant for the purchase of diver equipment in the amount of \$57,438.00 with a 5% match of \$2,872.00.

SECTION TWO:

New Franklin City Council acknowledges that matching funds in the amount of 5.0% are required if a Local Government Safety Capital Grant is awarded to New Franklin and agrees to appropriate those matching funds if the Grant is approved and accepted by New Franklin.

SECTION THREE:

The Finance Director is authorized and directed to certify that all local, public and/or other revenues listed in the grant


application are available for the project.

SECTION FOUR:



SECTION FIVE:


Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of New Franklin. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.


