

RESOLUTION NO: 16-R-26
SPONSOR: MAYOR BOLLAS; COUNCIL AS A WHOLE
INTRODUCED: APRIL 20, 2016

A RESOLUTION TERMINATING THE 1981 2.5 MILL CONTINUOUS NEW FRANKLIN POLICE LEVY UPON CERTIFICATION OF THE SUMMIT COUNTY BOARD OF ELECTIONS THAT NEW FRANKLIN VOTERS APPROVED A 1.0% INCREASE IN THE NEW FRANKLIN INCOME TAX AND DECLARING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON PASSAGE.

WHEREAS, New Franklin has a 1.0% income tax increase on the August 2016 special election ballot; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 5705.19(4), New Franklin has determined that the 1981 2.5 mill continuous police levy will be unnecessary and should be terminated if the income tax increase is approved.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

New Franklin Council and the Mayor have determined, pursuant to Ohio Revised Code 5705.19(4), that the 1981 2.5 Mill continuous police levy will be unnecessary and should be terminated if the 1.0% income tax increase is approved by New Franklin voters. The determination that the police levy is unnecessary and should be terminated is conditional and shall be effective when New Franklin receives a certification from the Summit County Board of Elections that the 1.0% income increase was approved by New Franklin voters. If New Franklin voters fail to approve the 1.0% income tax increase, then the 1981 2.5 mill continuous police levy shall remain in full force and effect.

SECTION TWO:

Once New Franklin receives certification from the Summit County Board of Elections that New Franklin voters approved the 1.0% income tax increase, the Finance Director is authorized and directed to take such actions as are necessary to terminate the collection of the 1981 2.5 mill continuous police levy. The Finance Director shall contact the Summit County Fiscal Office to determine what steps are necessary to terminate the 1981 2.5 mill continuous police levy.

SECTION THREE:

The elimination of the 1981 2.5 mill continuous police levy shall be effective January 1, 2016 for Tax Year 2016/ Collection Year 2017. The collection of the 2015 levy amounts shall take place in 2016.


SECTION FOUR:

The City of New Franklin finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this Resolution were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberation of this Council and any other Committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.


SECTION FIVE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of New Franklin. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.


