

RESOLUTION NO: 16-R-28
SPONSOR: MAYOR BOLLAS
INTRODUCED: MAY 4, 2016

A RESOLUTION ESTABLISHING A WAGE SCALE FOR THE SEASONAL MAINTENANCE WORKER POSITION AND DECLARING THAT THIS RESOLUTION SHALL BE EFFECTIVE IMMEDIATELY UPON PASSAGE.

WHEREAS, the City of New Franklin hires seasonal maintenance workers to assist in maintenance of the City Parks and Service Department functions; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor believes that a wage scale is necessary for this position; and

WHEREAS, the wage scale for seasonal maintenance workers will be established as beginning at the current minimum wage to a maximum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per hour.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF NEW FRANKLIN, COUNTY OF SUMMIT, AND STATE OF OHIO, THAT:

SECTION ONE:

The seasonal maintenance worker wage scale shall be established as beginning at the current ^{OK} minimum wage to a maximum of Ten Dollars (\$10.00) per hour. This wage scale shall be effective upon passage of this Resolution.


SECTION TWO:

The City of New Franklin finds and determines that all formal actions of this Council concerning and relating to the adoption of this legislation were taken in open meetings of this Council and any deliberation of this Council and any other Committees that resulted in those formal actions were in meetings open to the public, in compliance with all legal requirements.


SECTION THREE:

Council declares this to be an emergency immediately necessary for the preservation of the public peace, health, safety and welfare of the citizens of New Franklin. Provided that this legislation receives the affirmative vote of three-fourths of the members elected or appointed to Council, it shall take effect and be in force immediately upon its passage and approval by the Mayor; otherwise, it shall take effect and be in force at the earliest time allowed by law.


